This letter notifies the NWB that Kivalliq Energy's 2012 exploration program conducted from the Nutaaq field camp has been completed. Active exploration ceased on September 15, the Nutaaq camp was winterized and all operations were ceased on November 5, 2012. Approximately 33,500 metres of diamond drilling and 5,200 metres of RC drilling were completed under the 2012 program.
