This letter notifies the NWB that Kivalliq Energy's 2013 exploration program conducted from the Nutaaq Camp has been completed. Active exploration concluded, the Nutaaq Camp was winterized and all operations were ceased on July 21, 2013. A solar powered electric bear fence was raised around camp, all food was flown to Baker Lake and all fuel is in secondary containment. Approximately 2,101 metres of diamond drilling and soil sampling were completed under the 2013 program.
