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This letter notifies the NWB that Kivalliq Energy's 2014 exploration program conducted from the Nutaaq Camp has been completed. Active exploration concluded, the Nutaaq Camp was winterized and all operations were ceased on September 15, 2014. Approximately 1,300 line kilometres of airborne VTEM geophysical surveying was completed and approximately 1,500 soil samples were collected under the 2014 program.
