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This letter notifies NWB that Kivalliq Energy's 2015 exploration program on the Angilak Property conducted from the Nutaaq Camp has been completed. All operations were ceased and the camp was winterized and shut down on July 30, 2015. A total of 958 metres of diamond drilling was completed in nine drill holes centered on the Dipole target approximately 35 kilometres west of the camp.
