COMMENCEMENT OF FIELD OPERATIONS AT THE ANGILAK PROPERTY

This letter is to notify Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada ("CIRNAC"), the Nunavut Water Board ("NWB"), the Kivalliq Inuit Association ("KIA") and the Workers' Safety and Compensation Commission ("WSCC") that Latitude Uranium Inc. (5833 Nunavut Inc.), a wholly owned subsidiary of ATHA Energy Corp., will be commencing the summer phase of mineral exploration activities at the Angilak Project.

The summer program is anticipated to be completed by mid-September and will comprise diamond drilling, airborne geophysical surveys, mapping and rock sampling, as well as continued environmental baseline sampling and monitoring.

All operations conducted will adhere to conditions specified in the CIRNAC Land Use Permit ("LUP") N2019C0013, NWB Water Licence 2BE-ANG2227 and KIA land use licence KVL308C09.
