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## UPDATE ON FIELD OPERATIONS AT THE ANGILAK PROPERTY

This letter is to notify Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC), the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) and the Kivalliq Inuit Association (KIA) that ATHA Energy Corp. (ATHA), through its subsidiary Latitude Uranium Inc. (5833 Nunavut Inc.), has updated the 2025 work plan for mineral exploration activities at the Angilak Project.

The planned exploration work for 2025 was to be undertaken in two separate field programs, with a break in between, but will now run continuously through to the fall. The 2025 spring program of mobilization of fuel and supplies to the Nutaaq camp commenced on March 7, 2025. The spring mobilization will now be followed up with a ground geophysical program, which will be supported out of a temporary camp in the area of the Rib Showing. See attached figure. The ground geophysical survey is anticipated to commence April 20, 2025 and be completed May 20, 2025.

The 2025 summer program is anticipated to commence at the end of ground geophysical program. The summer program will still comprise diamond drilling, mapping, rock sampling and environmental baseline sampling and monitoring.

All operations conducted will adhere to conditions specified in the CIRNAC Land Use Permit (LUP) N2019C0013, NWB Water Licence 2BE-ANG2227 and KIA land use licence KVL308C09.
