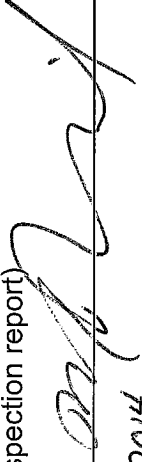

The Anialik River Project is located approximately 140 km West-North-West of Umingmaktok within the Kitikmeot Region, Nunavut. Location of the Anialik River Project includes parts of IOL parcels CO-30 and CO-81, minerals claims RUSH1 (F76271), RUSH2 (F76272), RC1 to RC12 (F91871 to F91882) inclusive, SNOW1 (F76061) and SNOW2 (F76062).

North Arrow Minerals Inc. (“North Arrow”) is a mineral exploration company dedicated to exploring for economic mineral deposits in Canada. North Arrow conducts extensive exploration programs within Nunavut and the Northwest Territories. North Arrow Minerals Inc. applied for and was awarded the assignment of 2BE-ANI0608 prior to its expiry in 2008, and the renewal licence was issued in North Arrow's name. No work has been conducted during North Arrow's tenure of the project, however, prospecting, mapping, and geochemical sampling were conducted out of the Rush Lake camp in 2004 and 2005 on this project.

The Rush Lake Camp (N67°23'27.0" W111°04'49.8") was inspected July 5 2013. Evidence of the camp was found as per the coordinates given in the 2004 and 2005 annual reports. The camp has been reclaimed, with only tent-pad outlines visible to mark the location, aside from one door/frame that was noted.

Non-Compliance with the Act or the Licence:
None.

Action Required:
As per Part I item 6, the Licensee shall remove from site all material prior to the expiry of this Licence.

Cancellation of the licence is not recommended until these matters are addressed.

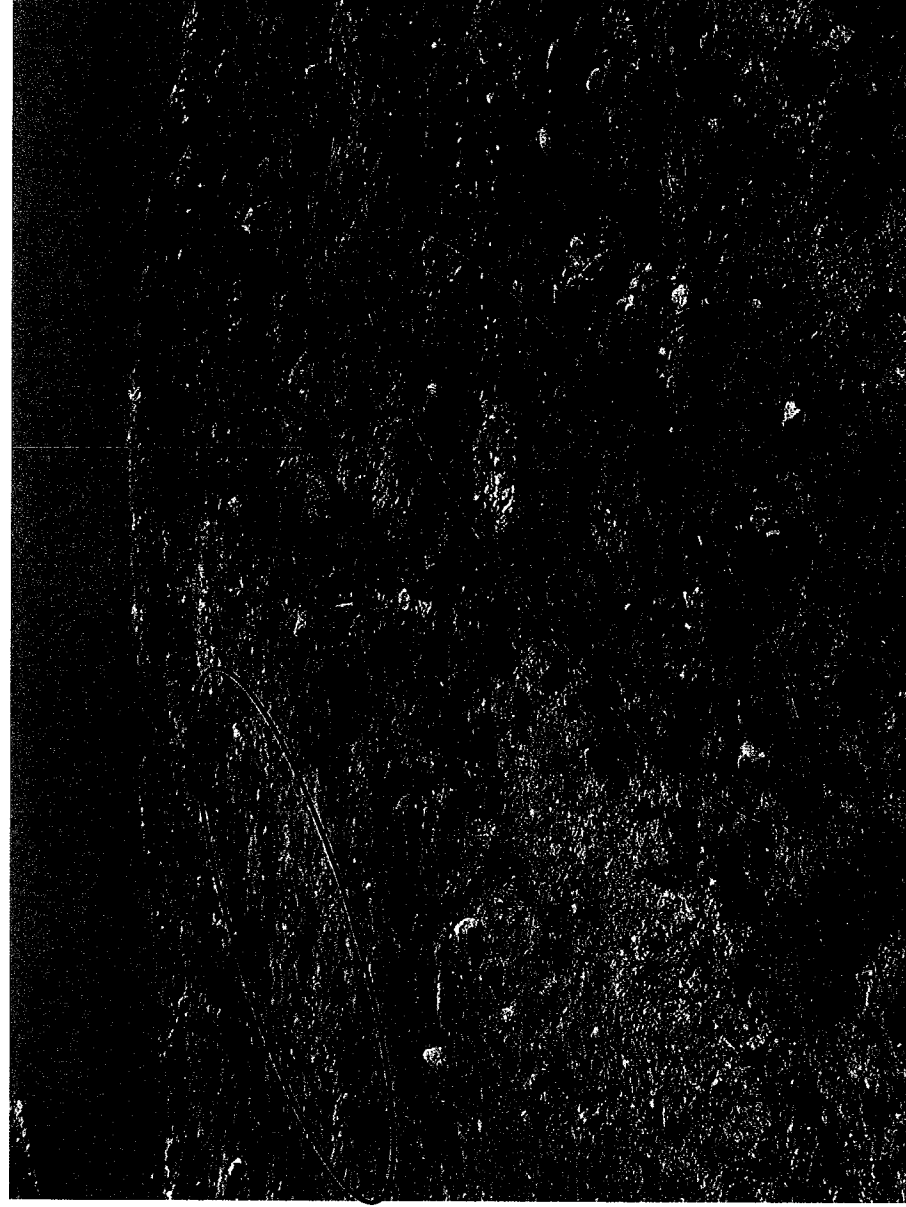


Figure 1. Tent pad outlines from Rush Lake Camp.
