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### A. BACKGROUND

On June 6, 2014 the Nunavut Water Board (NWB or the Board) provided notice to Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) that North Arrow Minerals Inc. had submitted an application for cancellation for Type 'B' Water Licence No. 2BE-ANI0813.

The Board has requested that interested parties review the above mentioned application and provide recommendations and/or comments by July 6, 2014.

### B. RESULTS OF REVIEW

On behalf of the AANDC Water Resources Division, the following recommendations/comments are presented for the NWB's consideration in regards to the above mentioned Water Licence Cancellation Application.

#### 1. Final Inspection of Site

**Comment:** In an Inspection report dated July 5, 2013, completed by an AANDC Water Resource Officer, it was noted that there was still debris to be removed from site.

**Recommendation:** AANDC recommends that the licence not be cancelled until a Water Resource Officer completes an on-site inspection and provides confirmation that no compliance issues are associated and/or remain outstanding with the project. AANDC notes that a final inspection will only be carried out once the company notifies the inspector that all debris has been removed.
