This license has expired and the camp locations authorized under its authority have had abandonment and reclamation activities conducted on them.
8. ABANDONMENT MEASURES The following measures have been taken to address the final abandonment conditions required by the licence: (explain, with drawings, how abandonment conditions of the licence have been met; how stream channels have been rehabilitated; how tailings have been recontoured; how instream structures have been removed; and how waste materials have been disposed of. All details of the abandonment and restoration measures conducted at the two camp locations established under the authority of 2BE-ASH0611 can be found in the report which accompanied the original letter requesting the closure of this license submitted to the Nunavut Water Board on June 25, 2013.
It is recognized that during an inspection conducted on September 16, 2013 by Eva Paul, Water Resources Officer, it was noted that a drill rod and a board were discovered at one of the drill site locations utilized during the 2005 exploration season. As a result of this the inspector has directed that reclamation be conducted and proven at all seven drill sites used over the course of that program, and that a report with photographs be submitted by September 30, 2014.
Stornoway Diamond Corporation will proceed with the inspector's directives during the region's snow-free period in 2014 and submit the requested report within the time frame mandated.
