Subject: Ashton Mining (NWT) Limited – Ashton Projects – Request for Screening – Renewal

The Nunavut Water Board received an application for water license renewal on April 14, 2003 from Ashton Mining (NWT) Ltd. for water use and waste disposal associated with exploratory drilling. The proponent has requested that the renewal application encompass 5 licenses in one, namely NWB2EOK0103, NWB2KIG0002, NWB2KLA0103, NWB2RIC0205 and NWB2VAM0205.

In accordance with Articles 12 and 13 of the Agreement Between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada, this project shall be screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board to determine whether it has significant impact potential, and whether it requires review, before the application can be processed by the Nunavut Water Board. These are all previously screened projects.
