Figure 2: Topographic Map Detailing the 2011 Summer Exploration Camp

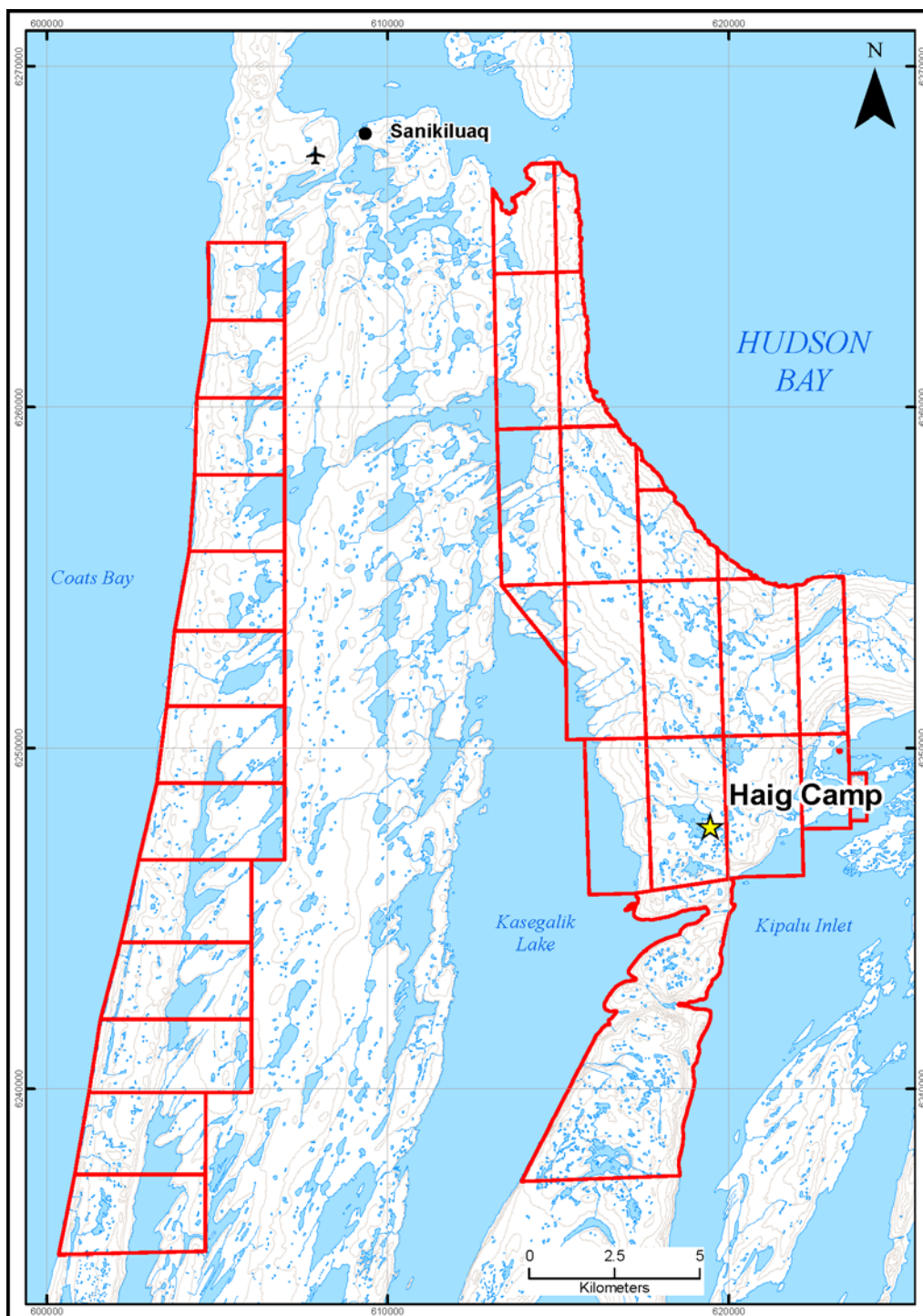
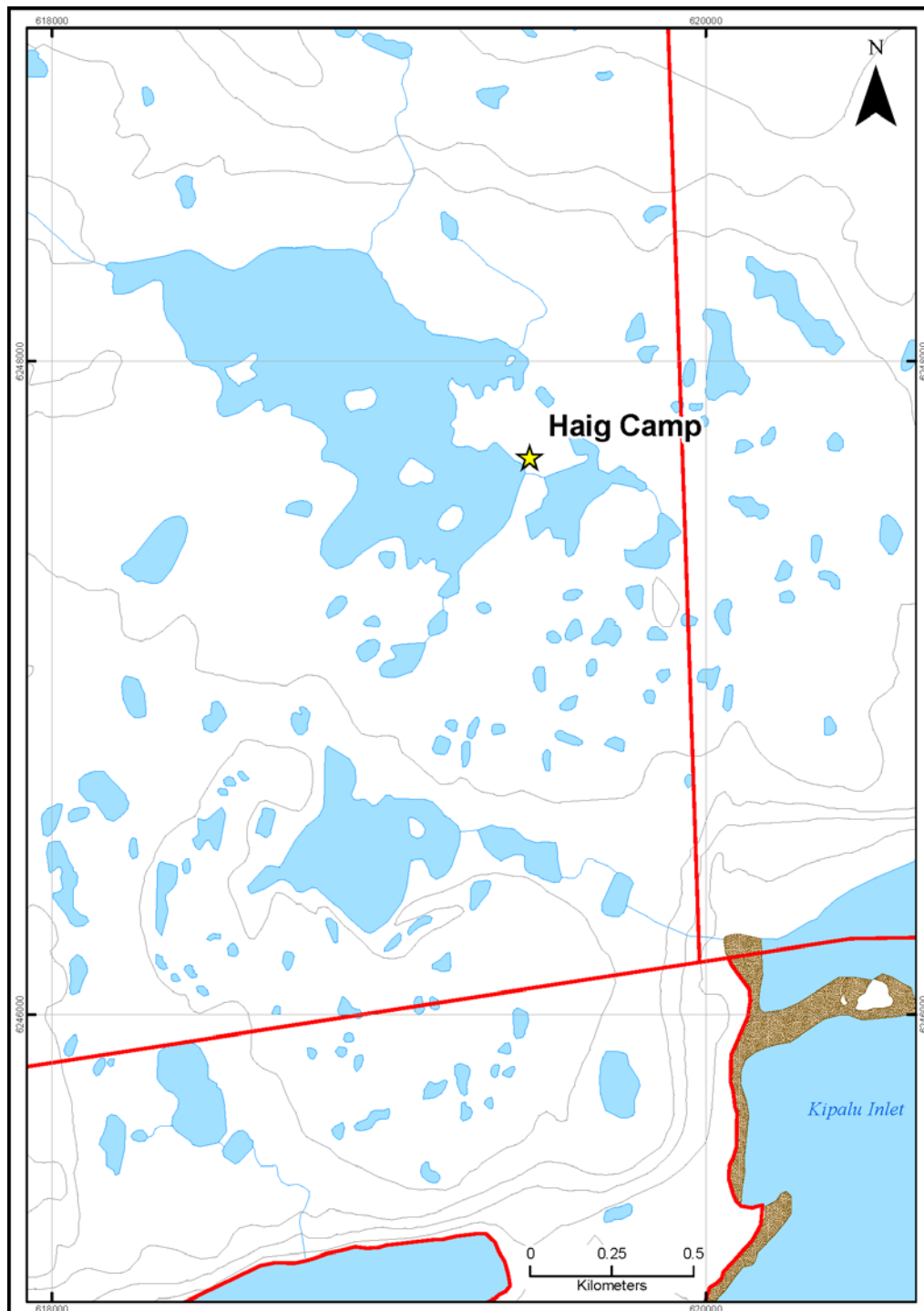


Figure 3: Close-up Map of 2011 Summer Exploration Camp Location
