Dear Ms. Beaulieu:

The Kitikmeot Inuit Association (KIA) has reviewed the cancellation request submitted by Skybridge Development Corporation (Skybridge). This project is located on Inuit Owned Land (IOL; Parcel BB-11), and the KIA holds a Land Use Licence with Skybridge (KTL308C001) which allows the proponent to access this parcel.

The KIA's Lands Officer has contacted Skybridge and has attempted to gather some information pertaining to this project. Although Skybridge has demonstrated a willingness to provide the requested information, our Lands Officer has been unable to address these information gaps due to scheduling conflicts.

Additionally, the KIA would need to complete a satisfactory close-out inspection of the IOL parcel and the camp site before we would be in a position to approve this cancellation request.

For these two reasons, therefore, the KIA cannot currently support Skybridge's Type "B" water licence cancellation request. We look forward to working with Skybridge, and we expect to address these outstanding items as quickly as logistics will allow.
