As the Water Resource Officer for Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada in the Kitikmeot Region, Nunavut, I am currently planning my compliance inspection schedule for the 2013 field season. Requests for cancellation of 2BE-BLU0812 is on file with the Nunavut Water Board (NWB). The NWB has requested that final inspections be conducted by an inspector duly appointed under the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* prior to the cancellation of the licence.

I am in possession of the compliance report submitted to Melissa Joy on October 25, 2012. This report shows that a final cleanup has been conducted of the site. In order to conduct a fulsome inspection, the following coordinates (Lat/Lon hddd°mm'ss.s", in NAD 83) are required:

- Any camp locations that were used at any time during the project.
- Air strip/landing locations.
- All drilling locations for the life of the project.
- All fuel caches that existed in the course of the project.

This information is critical to plan and prepare for my site visit; a prompt reply would be greatly appreciated. Without this information I will not attempt to inspect the site. I look forward to facilitating the cancellation of this licence.
