Pursuant to its authority under Article 13 of the *Agreement between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada* and the *Nunavut Waters* and the *Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*, the Nunavut Water Board hereby grants the following Licence amendment.

The Licence issued May 27, 2008 shall be amended to include the following terms and conditions, with respect to use of water and deposit of waste during camp and drilling operations, to allow for camp facilities and increased water use and an extended Water Licence at the Blue Caribou Project in the Kitikmeot Region, based at the camp located on Sage Lake with an expiry date of December 3, 2012 at latitude 65°14'18"N and longitude 106°36'07"W.

As requested in the July 29, 2008 letter to the NWB, all Water Licenses previously issued to Ayris Gold Corporation will now be renewed or amended to the parent company Skybridge Development Corporation.

The Licence, (Page 2), shall be amended to indicate the following:

PART C: CONDITIONS APPLYING TO WATER USE

Amend Item 1

1. The Licensee shall obtain all water for domestic camp use from Sage Lake. Drill water shall be obtained from lakes and ponds, proximal to the drilling targets as outlined in the Application. Total water use, for all purposes shall not exceed ninety (90) cubic metres per day.

Amend Item 1

1. The Board has approved the Plan entitled “Spill Contingency Plan, Skybridge Development Corporation” dated August 12, 2008 that was submitted as additional information. The Licensee shall submit within thirty (30) days of issuance of the amendment, an addendum to the plan to remove reference to contacting regulatory agencies for disposal instructions for contaminants as requested in GN-DOE comments;

PART I: CONDITIONS APPLYING TO ABANDONMENT AND RESTORATION PLANNING OR TEMPORARY CLOSING

Amend Item 1

1. The Board has approved the Plan entitled “Abandonment and Restoration Plan, Skybridge Development Blue Caribou Project” dated August 1, 2008 that was submitted as additional information. The Licensee shall submit within thirty (30) days of issuance of the amendment, an addendum to the plan to update section 6.5 to indicate removal of incinerator ash and non-combustible waste from the site as referred to in the supplementary questionnaire.
