Dear Ms. Beaulieu:

At your request, the Department of Culture, Language Elders and Youth (CLEY), Government of Nunavut, has reviewed the above-noted application. Our recommendations are limited to CLEY's mandate and follow.

We recommend approval of the above-cited application, as the proponent's proposed activities do not constitute a threat to known archaeological resources. If the proponent's activities take place on IOL then the QIA may be informed of the location of archaeological sites. The Archaeological Survey of Canada has no jurisdiction over this information and therefore it is not necessary to forward Nunavut data to them.

The attached conditions specify plans and methods of site protection and restoration to be followed by the permittee if an archaeological site is encountered or disturbed in the course of the land use activity.
