There should be a full public hearing (NWB and NIRB) into this coal application for the following reasons:

- The application is incomplete - it does not even detail a camp location Presumably a location will be selected with low-level flights, however flights below 1000m are prohibited by transport Canada regulations because they harass wildlife. There is no wildlife mitigation plan addressing this. It simply says that flights will be 'avoided' when these flights are PROHIBITED, and are NOT allowed below 1000m - the 300 m height is therefore completely unacceptable.
- inadequate den site buffer zones
- inadequate migratory bird buffers
- The application provides no details regarding storage of hazardous waste and fuel. It also does not indicate where the fuel will be transported to. Will Grise Fiord have to take the hazardous waste and incinerator ash?
- there is no record of any community consultations taking place.
- there is clear public concern about the paleontological sites that has been expressed.
