## Rita:

Attached are maps showing two possible locations for the camp on the Brodeur Peninsula as well as a description of the type of camp that will be put in.

One of the proposed camps is in IOL AB62, the other on crown land. Whichever camp is chosen will include a fuel cache for the helicopter of up to 8 drums of jet fuel (approx. 1,632L). Three other fuel caches are proposed, all on crown land. The small barrels on the Brodeur Peninsula (west coast) map represent the fuel cache sites.

We've narrowed it down such that a relatively precise location can be seen with the topography, but until we are on the ground, the actual campsite cannot be chosen. Hopefully this information will do for the time being.

This information is also being forwarded to QIA and DIAND-Iqaluit for those respective licences or permits.
