Re: The proposed camp for Kennecott Canada Exploration Inc. on the Broduer Peninsula

The camp being proposed is a small camp for reconnaissance work on the Broduer Peninsula. The camp will house anywhere from three to eight people, but will probably be six for most of the program. The camp should consist of three wall type tents. Two of these will be smaller for sleeping and accommodation probably fourteen by sixteen feet, and the third will be a larger tent to be used as a kitchen / dry and office space about twice the size. The camp will be powered by a small portable generator. The dry and kitchen will be the only place that water will be used, a small container, in the order of 200 gallons or less, will be used to store water inside this tent. The grey water will be managed in buckets or plumbed and discarded in to a sump. The sump will be sufficiently deep to handle the grey water requirements of the camp and far enough from any body of water as required by permits. The tents frames will be constructed using dimensional lumber frames and plywood floors. The camp will be built so as to make the tents as close to each other as possible to accommodate power, however sufficiently far enough apart to eliminate the threat of a fire destroying the whole camp.
