Kennecott has recently found out that the camp used in our 2001 program has been ransacked. With that and the fact that our surveys will take place on or near our mineral claims and permits, we would like to relocate the camp. The parameters for the new camp will be the same as in our current licence, and until our personnel are on the Brodeur Peninsula, we can only provide several locations as to possible sites for a new camp. Attached is a map indicating the possible locations.

A request for an amendment has been submitted to DIAND for a new camp location, and we would like to know what procedure we must follow for NWB to change the camp location. The time factor is of concern that we have a very small window for summer operations in this area, and are planning to start work on or around July 1. DIAND has sent the amendment to the NPC and we assume it will go to NIRB for review of the possible locations. Once it is approved by NIRB would this be sufficient to change the camp location in our NWB license?
