Exploration activities involved a 28-day and an 11-day (May 3<sup>rd</sup>-31<sup>st</sup> and July 2<sup>nd</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>, respectively) prospecting and geochemical sampling program, as well as ground geophysical surveys. The camp was located at 62° 07' 46 N and 111° 05' 52" W. Water for domestic purposes by the Allyn crew was acquired from Canoe Lake. Domestic consumption varied from 75L to 100L per day for a 5-person camp. The location of where water was obtained was 62° 07' 45.4" N and 111° 05' 52" W. All sewage and grey-water are buried in pits or sumps located more than 30 metres from the high tide mark and combustible waste incinerated daily in burn barrels.
