**RE: NWB Technical Review of 2017 Annual Report for the Committee Bay Property;
Water Licence No. 2BE-CBP1722**

Dear Mr. Capponi and Ms. Gunson:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB) has completed a technical review of the 2017 Annual Report provided to the NWB on December 22, 2017. On January 10, 2018, the NWB acknowledged receipt of the Annual Report and provided it to the Kivalliq and Kitikmeot distribution lists for information. No comments have been received to date.

The technical review of the Annual Report found that the information generally addresses the requirements of the Licence. Thank you for indicating that no Water use or Waste deposit occurred in 2017.

The NWB notes that the Licensee has not provided all the submissions previously required by the Licence:

- Part H, Item 2:

The Licensee shall revise the *Spill Prevention and Response Plan, Committee Bay Property, Nunavut, Canada*, dated June 1, 2017 to include a topography map with the proposed location of the camp, related water bodies, fuel cache location, and the spill kit locations. These revisions to the Plan shall be submitted in the form of an Addendum to be included with the 2017 Annual Report.

To date, the NWB has no record of receiving this information.

- Part I, Item 2:

The Licensee shall revise the *Abandonment and Restoration Plan, Committee Bay*

Property, Nunavut, Canada, dated June 1, 2017 to include topography maps, site location details for the fuel and proposed camp locations. The Licensee shall also revise the title of the plan to include the word “Closure” rather than “Abandonment”, in accordance with Guidelines for the Closure and Reclamation of Advanced Exploration and Mine Sites in the Northwest Territories, 2013. These revisions to the Plan shall be submitted in the form of an Addendum to be included with the 2017 Annual Report.

To date, the NWB has no record of receiving this information.
