At your request, the Department of Culture, Language Elders and Youth (CLEY), Government of Nunavut, has reviewed the above-noted application. Our recommendations are limited to CLEY's mandate and follow.

We recommend the applicant retain the services of a professional consulting archaeologist to conduct a preliminary heritage resource inventory of the project area. An assessment is required to assist the applicant with avoiding recorded and unrecorded heritage resources and project planning in relation to heritage resources.

The attached is a list of consultants with experience working in Nunavut who may be contacted to conduct an assessment and CLEY "Guidelines for Developer". Other professional archaeological consultants may also be hired.
