<u>Camps (Discovery, Sunrise, Aurora, CH-6)</u> : Approximately 3 m³ per camp day. Peregrine does not intend to operate camps simultaneously. Camps are used when in close proximity to work site activities for safety. For example CH-6 camp is close to kimberlite CH-6 and Discovery Camp is close to kimberlites CH-7 and CH-44. It is anticipated that, as in the past, domestic water usage will be substantially below the allocated 25m³
Drilling (core, RC): Peregrine is requesting additional usage of water for "drilling and other purposes. This is to accommodate recent changes in the interpretation of 'Water Use" by AANDC and to accommodate some increased core drilling activity in the future. Calculations outlined above in Section 13 detail the calculations for an increase in the water volume threshold. The new threshold for "drilling and other purposes" is 221 cubic meters per day.




