The Government of Nunavut – Culture, Language, Elders and Youth (GN- CLEY) has reviewed the material for an amendment and extension to Peregrine’s Chidliak project. In particular, to establish a third temporary camp.

The department does not object to the application. However, our records indicate that the closest archaeological site is 15 km. north-west of the proposed camp extension. The proponent must appreciate that it is their responsibility to ensure that no palaeontological or archaeological sites are disturbed in the course of their activities.

All archaeological and palaeontological sites in Nunavut are protected by law. Should any site be encountered, the proponent must contact the Department of Culture, Language, Elders and Youth.
