Greetings, Don,

Peregrine will be mobilising two core drills this summer to the Chidliak property (NWB Type B Water Licence #2BE-CHI0813), with the intention of drilling up to 8 000m. A map of provisional land-based drillhole locations is attached.

As there is no meterage limit in Part F of Licence #2BE-CHI0813, do you believe that our announcing the intended maximum drilling metres three months in advance is sufficient? (The winter-spring drill programme, which is intended between mid-March and early June 2010, will consist of approximately 4 000m; the provisional plan for this lake-based drilling is already on file with your office.)
