On February 28, 2007 NIRB received notification that a positive conformity determination had been made on this project proposal by the Nunavut Planning Commission. NIRB has assigned this project proposal file number, 07EN023. The project proposal involves amendments to existing land use permits with INAC and the KIA for a test pit trenching and bulk sampling program. Specific project activities include:
