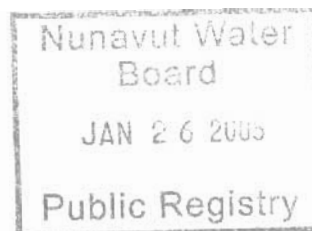

THERE ARE NUMBER OF CONCERNS, I WISH
TO EXPRESS AS A LOCAL HUNTER AND
COMMERCIAL FISHERMAN. I'M SURE THE
RESIDENT OF CHESTERFIELD INLET, WILL
ALSO BE CONCERNS ONCE FOUND-OUT AS
WELL AS LOCAL HTO.

MY FIRST CONCERNS IS THAT SHEAR
MINERALS LTD. USES OUTSIDE KNOWLEDGE
IN SELECTING THE AREA FOR CAMP AND
AIRSTRIIP. UNDER THE LAND CLAIM AGREEMENT
THE PROPOSED AREA FOR THE CAMP AND
AIRSTRIIP IS UNDER CHESTERFIELD INLET
LAND QUANTUM AND THEREFORE ITS ONLY
RIGHT FOR CHESTERFIELD INLET HAMLET
TO BE CONSULTED TO MAKE SELECTION
OF PROPOSED CAMP AND AIRSTRIIP AREA.

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MY SECOND CONCERN IS THAT, THE CONSTRUCTION AND MOBILIZATIONS OF THE CAMP WILL AGAIN BE FROM RANKIN INLET OVER LAND, WHICH IS WELL OVER 50 MILES. WHY SHOULD THE CONSTRUCTION AND MOBILIZATIONS BE DONE FROM CHESTERFIELD INLET ITS LESS THAN 17 MILES?

MY THIRD CONCERN IS THAT, JOSEPHINE LAKE IS ARCTIC CHAR RUN LAKE, WITH JOSEPHINE RIVER WITH ITS COMMERCIALS FISHING QUOTA, ~~ITS~~ AND ITS FISHING QUOTA IS CONTROLLED BY D.F.O.

MY FORTH CONCERN IS THAT PROPOSED CAMP IS SITUATED ON AN ISLAND IN JOSEPHINE LAKE, LOCATED ON N63'11.930' AND THE GRAYWATER WILL DRAIN INTO THE FISH LAKE, ALSO THE PROPOSTED AIRSTRIP IS SITUATED ALONG THE RIVER BANK OF JOSEPHINE RIVER WHICH IS LOCATED ON W091'12.690, WHICH WILL BOTH CREATED DRIANALE DOWN JOSEPHINE RIVER AND CAN ENJOKE OUR FISH.

MY SUGGESTION IS THAT HAMLET OF CHESTERFIELD INLET, BE CONSULTED WITH REPRESENTATIVES, BUSINESSES, HAMLET, ITU AND LOCAL HUNTERS AND FISHMEN TO MAKE SUITABLE SELECTION OF - 13

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PROPOSTED CAMP AND AIRSTRIP FOR
SHEAR MINERALS LTD, SO WE THE
RESIDENACE OF CHESTERFIELD INLET
MAY NOT HAVE TO CALL FOR IIBA.
