Dear Ms. Westcott:

The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB" or "Board") has completed a review of the above mentioned document submitted from Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada ("AANDC") to the Board on August 2, 2013. The report is based on observations made during a site visit of the closed and abandoned camp sites related to the project, located in the Kitikmeot and Kivalliq Regions, Nunavut. AANDC indicates that none of the remaining infrastructure associated with the camps were present on sites, and that no outstanding remediation issues were noted. AANDC recommends that this file may now be closed.

The NWB hereby informs all parties that the 2BE-CNA0608 file is now closed under the board motion # 2013-B1-034. Any future activities on this site involving the use of water or the deposit of waste will require a new licence.
