On July 10, 2014 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) received an application from your office for Tundra Copper Corporation's "Copper Exploration" project proposal. The NIRB has determined that this project proposal is exempt from screening pursuant to item 2 of Schedule 12-1 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), *Types of Project Proposals Exempt from Screening*:

NLCA Schedule 12-1 (2):

*"Land use activities requiring only a Class B permit under the Territorial Land Use Regulations (SOR/77-210 4 March 1977)."*
