Dear Phyllis,

As you are aware we have an existing Class B Land Use Permit (N2014C0015) and associated Water Use Permit (2BE – COP1416) that covers exploration with a <400 person-day camp in the original 2014 Tundra licences. While we are waiting for a decision - hopefully positive! - on our more recent Class A Land Use Permit and Water Use amendment applications, we thought it appropriate to let you know that we intend to mobilize our camp and begin drilling under our existing permits.

The camp build will take place from July 2nd to the 13th. This will be followed by helicopter mobilization to commence the archeological survey and wildlife scan on July 15th, and drill equipment mobilization on the 16th. We would expect drilling to commence two or three days after that. Until such time as the Class A permit and water permit ammendment come through, we of course will operate within the terms and conditions of our existing Class B Land Use and Water permits.

I have also cc'd the project geologist Sarah Clay and VP exploration, Dave Broughton. Many thanks for your assistance with our file and please do not hesitate to contact us should any concerns or questions arise.
