Item 9 of Water License Application: Description of Undertaking

The purpose of the program is to explore for copper mineralization using geochemical soil and rock sampling surveys, prospecting, diamond drilling and geological mapping.

The main focus of this year's program will be a diamond drilling program, in success contingent phases, to evaluate and verify previously discovered copper deposits. Up to 4,800 metres of core diamond drilling in 28 holes will be conducted.

The drilling will take place primarily on a combination of the company's mineral claims, prospecting permits and on Inuit Owned Land as shown in the attached maps (Figures 3 and 4).

A seasonal camp for approximately 14 people will be set up near Hope Lake on the Mac claim (Figures 1 and 2). It will consist of wood framed canvas tents with plywood floors. Transport will be via helicopter stationed in camp with supplies brought in by fixed wing aircraft from Yellowknife and Kugluktuk. When the program is completed for the 2015 field season, the tents will be packed up and either stored on site or flown out until needed for the 2015 season.
