Item 9 of 2021 NWB Water License Renewal Application: Description of Undertaking

At this time no program is planned for the immediate future, however we want to maintain our water license in good standing in the event that we want to proceed with plans previously designed for exploration across our Coppermine claims.

The purpose of an exploration program at Coppermine is to explore for copper mineralization using geochemical soil and rock sampling surveys, prospecting, core drilling, trenching and geological mapping on the company's claims.

At this time, there is approximately 3,000 soils samples planned for collection and 2,000 metres of core diamond drilling in five holes and 500 metres of trenching to evaluate and verify previously discovered copper deposits; should we decide to proceed with an exploration program.

The drilling will take place on claims TKW 28; RML 5; RML 7; RML 8; TKE 15. Trenching will be comprised of numerous short trenches on various historic showings for an aggregate total length not exceeding 500 metres. See attached Figure 2 for reference.

A seasonal camp may be set up for up to 9 people in the event we proceed with exploration. At this time the location of the camp is unknown, it would likely be close to one of the proposed drill sites. Any temporary seasonal camp would consist of tents and/or wood framed canvas tents with plywood floors. Transport will be via helicopter stationed in camp and supplies brought in by fixed wing aircraft from Yellowknife and Kugluktuk. See attached drawing of proposed camp.

Once a program is complete, all temporary camp items will be removed from the property.
