I am writing to you on behalf of Tundra Copper Corp., a mineral exploration company that is planning to conduct general exploration activities on the Coppermine River Property, located in the Kitikmeot, Nunavut region, to continue a consultation process in order to ensure that our activities align with expectations and limitations set out by land stewards and users. Tundra Copper is conducting a ground exploration program on the Coppermine River Property, a property that covers 169,515 hectares (~1695km<sup>2</sup>) on Crown Land and is located approximately 7 km southwest of Kugluktuk, Nunavut.

Tundra is committed to responsible and sustainable exploration. As such, we are committed to preserving the environment, respecting Indigenous rights, and fostering positive relationships with the communities where we work.

As part of our consultation process, we would like to open dialogue with representatives from your community. Through these conversations, we hope to:



1. Share information about our exploration activities at the Coppermine River Property, including our objectives, methodologies, and potential impacts on the environment and community.
2. Listen to your perspectives and concerns regarding our activities and the broader development of the region and incorporate your feedback into our approach to operating in the region.
3. Explore avenues for community engagement, including potential employment opportunities, as we plan for larger-scale exploration programs at the Coppermine River Property in the future.
4. Establish mechanisms for ongoing communication and feedback throughout the duration of our exploration activities.

We understand that consultation is a two-way process, and we are committed to actively listening and responding to your feedback. Your insights and expertise are invaluable to us as we strive to conduct our operations in a manner that is respectful, transparent, and mutually beneficial.
