Please note that as per the closure summary accompanying this application the Eureka camp remained under an INAC storage authorization following the expiration of this license and was re-opened in 2011 under the authority of Type “B” license 2BE-CGP1012 to support a short, summer drill program. Details of the final abandonment and reclamation activities conducted at the Eureka camp location under the authority of that license can be found in the final land use report which accompanied the closure application for 2BE-CGP1012 submitted to the Nunavut Water Board on July 26, 2012.
