



COMMITTEE BAY PROJECT

NON-TECHNICAL SUMMARY

December 2015

Company information

North Country Gold Corp. ('NCGC') is a Canadian exploration company that is actively exploring the Committee Bay Project ('CBP') within the Eastern Kitikmeot region of Nunavut Territory. Over the past 20 years NCGC (and its predecessor companies including Committee Bay Resources Ltd) have conducted mineral exploration across the CBP and have successfully identified significant gold mineralization at over 40 sites. Auryn Resources Inc. ('AUG') acquired NCGC via a share based transaction in September of 2015. NCGC remains the operator of the Committee Bay Project as a 100% owned subsidiary of AUG.

Committee Bay Project

The CBP presently encompasses more than 217,000 hectares of mineral claims and leases along the Committee Bay Greenstone Belt, extending from Committee Bay in the north, approximately 300 km to the southwest, towards Baker Lake and the Meadowbank Mine. The project includes the Three Bluffs gold deposit, significant gold occurrences at West Plains, Inuk, Anuri, Raven, Cop-Four Hills, many other gold occurrences and excellent untested targets that are not exposed at surface.

Proposal

NCGC is planning to continue exploration at the CBP during the spring and summer of 2016. The following work is proposed in 2016:

- Airborne geophysical surveys.
- Continued aerial drone photographic and topographic surveying.
- Ground IP geophysical surveys over selected prospects.
- Regional Soil and Till sampling surveys.
- Prospecting and Geological Mapping: mapping and/or gridding on various scales, property wide.
- Use of up to 2 GT RAB drills (rubber track mounted) to systematically sample bedrock in a quick and cost effective manner over selected areas.
- Diamond drill programs at Three Bluffs and other targets defined by RAB drilling and prospecting.
- Use of up to 12 fly camps (up to 2 concurrently) to facilitate geophysics, drilling, soils sampling and/or prospecting in remote locations.
- Upgrading of Bullion Camp to facilitate up to 40 personnel.

Vision

NCGC envisages that with additional exploration work Three Bluffs and other mineral deposits will be developed into sustainable mines across the Committee Bay area in years to come to the benefit of Nunavut, local communities and all stakeholders.
