Hi Jo,

Actually the 2BE-CRA1520 renewal licence includes the operation of 4 camps as approved under the previous licence: Hayes, Bullion, Ingot and Crater Camps. If saying fly camps you mean some of these camps, no additional authorization is needed for their operation.

Also, if the water sources / water use amounts and waste disposal means are in accordance with the licence conditions you do not need any additional authorization from the NWB. If these licence conditions are met the number of people in fly camp is not a subject of regulation by licence.

Let me please know whether this addresses your questions or the situation is different from the assumptions stated above.

Hello all,

As you may already know, North Country has joint ventured the Committee Bay Project with Auryn Resources based in Vancouver and we are all excited to get back to exploring.

We are investigating all exploration options for regional work and I did have one quick question with regards to fly camps. These would be temporary, handful of people for a week to 10 days in one spot before moving to another spot. Under our current Class B licence, are fly camps permitted? And if so, what might be the maximum number of people in a fly camp at any one time (assuming they are using 0.2m3 of water daily each for instance..) that would NOT trigger a NWB review or authorisation. I notice that in Sched 2, has a <50m3 threshold for authorisation. Would this also apply to any fly camps as part of 2BECRA1520?

Any info would be very helpful.
