This application is incomplete, it answers "yes" to a number of important questions and provides no details. It does not explain what community consultations took place or provide any proof. It does not explain how acid drainage will be prevented from the drill cuttings. It does not explain what wildlife mitigation steps will specifically be taken.

It also does not explain WHERE the waste is going. Incinerator ash is hazardous and must be disposed of at a licensed hazardous waste facility.

There should be a public hearing into this license.
