

You have to consult with the NPC regarding the applicable land use planning and assessment requirements for the project and submit the required documentation to the NPC directly. With NWB awaits the NPC's determination and/or directions indicating that the project may proceed to the licensing stage, the NWB may commence an administrative check for completeness preliminary internal technical review. If the NWB identifies deficiencies in your application, you may be notified of any additional information requirements. However, the NWB's official processing of the application will commence following issuance and receipt of the relevant decision(s) from the NPC and/or NIRB.

Given the very limited scope of the Amendment proposed the NPC/NIRB process will likely not take an extensive time.
