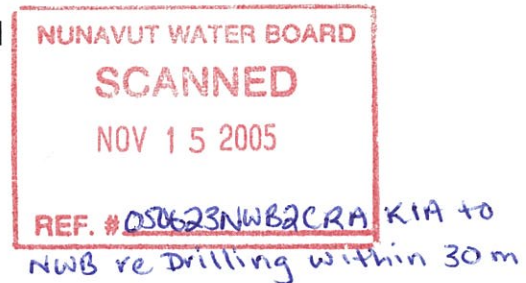

> courses. Can we still go ahead and drill these targets?? Obviously we  
> will make every effort will be made to capture drill cuttings at the top  
> of  
> the casing at pump them away (100m) onto land to the southwest and the  
> cuttings will be bermed or otherwise controlled at the discharge point to  
> insure it doesn't run directly into the lake.
