The Government of Nunavut (CLEY) has reviewed the material submitted by North Country Gold Corp. for the Committee Bay abandonment and restoration plan.

The department does not object to the plan. However, the department urges the proponent to be sensitive to the fact of one known heritage resource site within the proponent's area of activity: one archaeological site is seven km. to the East of the Ibex Cache.

All archaeological and palaeontological sites in Nunavut are protected by law and the proponent must understand that it is their responsibility to ensure no sites are disturbed in the course of activities. Should any additional sites or artifacts be encountered, the proponent must contact the Department of Culture, Language, Elders and Youth.
