Appendix E

Section 7.0 - Proposed Restoration Plans

At the completion of the exploration drill program all material, refuse and equipment will be removed from the site. Any lands affected by the campsite and drilling will be restored, to the most reasonable extent possible, to their original and natural state. All drill sumps will be restored to their natural contours of the land prior to the expiry of the permit.

Section 9.0 - Proposed Disposal Methods

- 9.0 (a) Combustible garbage will be burnt on site; non combustible material will be removed from site including metal wastes.
- 9.0 (b) Sewage will be contained in a sump and restored to the natural contours of the land prior to the expiry of the permit.
- 9.0 (c) Not applicable, work site above tree line.
- 9.0 (d) Drill cuttings and drilling fluids will be contained in a natural depression / sump located not less than 30 meters from the high water mark of any water body. All drill fluids will be recycled whenever possible.
