1. Each of these documents should have a site map indicating the locations of facilities and the placement of spill kits.
2. It is important to ensure that all contaminated materials are disposed of in the appropriate manner. In the A&R plan there is mention of inspecting for soil contamination (e.g. around the helicopter pad), but there should be a bit more discussion regarding what the plans are should the soil found to be polluted.
