Hi Phyllis,

My name is Meghan, and I'm a geologist with Tri Origin Exploration. We've been in contact with Christine Wilson regarding an exploration project we had in Nunavut back in 2007, and we need to cancel the land use permit and water licence for that project area. I think Christine has forwarded some of our past email correspondence to you.

Christine emailed me a package from the Nunavut Water Board (Guide 7 – Licensee Requirements following the Issuance of a Water Licence), and told me to get in touch with you and Tracey McCaie at AANDC for information on how to complete the water licence cancellation application. I have the cancellation application and I'm trying to fill it out, but have questions about section 9, the Certificate of Completion. I have emailed AANDC, but they have not replied to my emails or calls, and I was hoping you could respond to my concerns. Are the certificate of completion and the certificate of closure the same thing? And can I only get the certificate(s) from AANDC, or does the Nunavut Water Board provide the certificates as well? Is there anything else I need to provide to the Nunavut Water Board (other than the completed cancellation application and the certificate) in order to cancel the water licence?

I'm not entirely familiar with Nunavut's land use permitting or permit cancelling processes, so any help would be greatly appreciated.
