Good morning Ms Wilson and Mr Kablalik,

I just wanted to notify you that clean up of Tri Origin's former site near the air strip at Edehon Lake (coordinates N60 26 53.8 W97 32 27.3) has been completed, pending receipt of an activities report. According to the contractor hired to remove waste from the site, Ookpik Aviation, they have removed all debris (including fuel drums, propane tanks, garbage, lumber, etc.) from the site. Tri Origin is now waiting on a report from Ookpik documenting the measures taken to clean the site and list the materials removed. If you wish to perform a site visit to verify site cleanliness and that the debris has been removed, now might be the best time to go, weather permitting.
