

## LETTER OF NOTICE Pursuant to Section 41 (1) of the Territorial Land Use Regulations, CRC, c 1524

**RE:** - Letter of Notice

Pursuant to Section 41 (1) of the Territorial Land Use Regulations, CRC, c 1524, I hereby serve you Notice that Tri Origin Exploration Ltd. is found acting contrary to the provisions of land use authorization N2005C0036.

A compliance inspection was conducted on the 7th of September, 2011. The Inspector noted hazardous and domestic waste, timber, drilling salts, and a burn area remaining onsite.

Tri Origins Explorations Ltd. land authorizations states:

Section 31 (1) (a) (3)

"The Permittee shall remove from Territorial Lands, all scrap metal, discarded machinery and parts, barrels and kegs, buildings and building material."

And

Section 31 (1) (b) (7)

"The Permittee shall complete all clean-up and restoration of the lands used prior to the expiry date of this permit."

As no progression had been made to complete the restorations of site; the Permittee shall take all reasonable measures to correct the defaults detailed above before July 15, 2013.

Failing this pursuant to Section 41 (4) and (5) Territorial Land Use Regulations, CRC, c 1524;

(4) "Where a permittee has been informed of a default pursuant to subsection (1) or an order has been made in respect thereof pursuant to subsection (2), the engineer may, if the permittee fails to correct the default, take such action as he deems necessary to correct the default.



(5) "The costs of any action taken by the engineer pursuant to subsection (4) may be recovered from the permittee as a debt due to the Crown."
