Good morning Camille,

I suggest contacting the Nunavut water Board.

I note in the file that there was a 2006 Annual report filed but nothing for the years that follow. Under the Water License Part B Section 2 an annual report is required for each year of the license.. A nill report or letter indicating that no activity occurred on the site will likely be acceptable by the Board to cover off the 2008 year but any activity conducted in 2007 will still need to be reported.

As for a request for closure, that is simply a letter to the Nunavut Water Board requesting that the license be closed.

As I mentioned, it is my intention to conduct inspections on this site this year. To assist me in the inspection a copy of the 2007 annual report would be helpful as it should outline any drilling activities and locations so they may be inspected in addition to any camps or fuel caches used during the program.
