



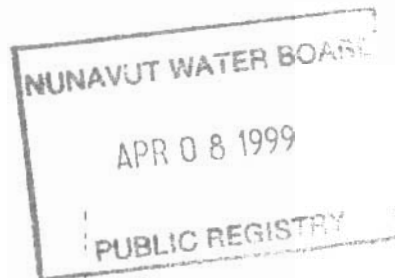

Dear Ms. Filiatrault,

Pursuant to our telephone conversation this date, I am enclosing the MSDS list of potential additives provided by Midwest Drilling of Thompson, Manitoba,

Question #23 - The company's spill contingency plan will consist of continuous monitoring of fuel storage sites. If there is a fuel spill the company will contain the spill and at which point will add pelletized absorbatives to remove any spilled material at which point it will dispose of either by burning or transporting to the Thompson for disposal.

Question #32 - Due to lack of air support out of Rankin Inlet, it has been decided that all materials in and out of Ferguson Lake will originate at Thompson Manitoba which has hazardous waste material handling.

Question 35 - During the summer program which is to start in July in conjunction with the exploration program, an environmental baseline study will be initiated. This baseline study will be designed by environmental consultants and I will ensure it will include leaching of water.

Question 37 - A propane toilet will no longer be used. A facility will be constructed overtop of the underground septic tank and all black water will be contained within the storage tank.

Question 38 - The Ferguson Lake Lodge greatly exceeds our use requirements and no further construction will be done. All empty fuel drums will be removed back to their origin.
