Dear Mr. Krause:

This is a reminder that your permit NWB2FER9901 for water use and waste disposal associated with exploration near Ferguson Lake for the Ferguson Lake Copper Nickel Project expires on April 22, 2001.

As indicated in Item 7.3 of the permit, a summary report needs to be submitted to the Nunavut Water Board annually and within 30 days of the expiry. This report should include information about activities for the above permit, water quality data, abandonment and restoration of the site, list any unauthorized spills and the follow-up action taken, and any other relevant water use and waste disposal information.

To date, the Nunavut Water Board has not received any annual reports. Please submit the annual report(s) as soon as possible and the final summary report prior to May 22, 2001.

Should you wish to continue with the exploration, you will need to file an application for renewal of this permit.

An application form and supplementary questionnaire are attached to this letter. These can be filed electronically, or if this is not possible, by fax, or by regular mail. Please allow 3-4 months for the renewal process. For an application to be deemed complete the following are needed:

- completed application form with maps
- completed supplementary questionnaire
- executive summary in both English and Inuktitut
- application fee of \$30 payable to the Receiver General of Canada
