Dear Mr. Krause:

The Nunavut Water Board acknowledges receipt on February 5, 2003 of your renewal water licence application for the Ferguson Lake Project. Your application included the following items:

- e-mail cover sheet dated February 5, 2003
- 2003 executive overview in English only
- application form
- supplementary questionnaire

In order to complete your application we require the \$30.00 application fee in the form of a cheque made payable to Receiver General for Canada. Also required is your executive summary translated to Inuktitut.

This project is currently being reviewed by NPC and screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board for their determination as to whether they require further review, or if it can be processed by the Nunavut Water Board.

I have been asked by the Board to inform you that a notice of your application is required. This notice of requirement is based on Article 13.3.14 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), which states that the Board should take "...all steps necessary by way of notice...to provide and promote public awareness [of hearings]."

Accordingly, a notice in both English and Inuktitut will be posted for a period of 30 days, with local establishments in Rankin Inlet, Whale Cove and Baker Lake.

Upon request from the public, we ask you to make available, free of charge, copies of all documents pertaining to this application. Any person who is affected by this application or
