Hi Francois,

I was processing the 2BE-FER0712 water licence renewal application, and I have a couple of quick questions.

The application's Project summary states that Ferguson Lake Fishing Lodge located on an island in Ferguson Lake as a base camp, and a New camp was established in 2007. From my understanding the scope of the 2BE-FER0712 included the operation of the New camp.

The last AANDC Inspection Report dated February 10, 2010, stated some issues identified in the Old Ferguson Lake Camp in 2007. The question: Is this the old camp stated in the Project Summary? If yes, what is the status of this old camp. You could maybe confirm whether or not this old camp was cleaned and restored since that? The 2009 July 25th and August 11th Inspection stated that the Camp was inactive. I guess this meant the New Camp?

The next question is: Did the Company provide a Report on clean-up activities conducted as a result of the Inspector's Direction issued to Starfield Resources Inc. on September 14, 2009 to the Inspector? Because the NWB records don't show that a Report was provided to the NWB.
